Associate the elastic IP to your public hostname

- () BEFORE PROCEEDING with a PRODUCTION NODE instance:
 - The administrator of your domain (usually someone in your IT department) will need to create a DNS record that maps to the public
 hostname you previously selected to the elastic IP address you just created.
 - Make sure that your public hostname resolves to the elastic IP address created above. You can use an online service to check, for example: http://www.whatsmydns.net/
 - 1. Go to your EC2 Dashboard
 - 2. In the left navigation bar, open the Network and Security section
 - 3. Select Elastic IPs
 - 4. Select the desired IP address from the list
 - 5. Click on the Actions button and select Associate Address
 - 6. Select the desired running instance for the Instance field
 - 7. Click on the Associate button
